Please join the High School Youth Group in our Advent Challenge. Clear out the clutter of your heart (so easy to acquire during this hurried season), so Jesus can make a dwelling there.

The Challenge has 5 easy steps:

- 1) Learn to say 'no' to your self. At least once during Advent, give up some treat you would normally buy yourself (latte, energy drink, etc.) and use that money to buy a canned food item for the food bank.
