



Knowing the Bible

Q. Why are Catholics ignorant of Scripture?

A. Naturally, to be fair, one would have to modify the question to speak of "some Catholics," for a group indictment would be very wrong and inaccurate.

Many Catholics are ignorant of the Scriptures for the same reason that they are ignorant of a whole variety of faith-related matters: a lack of education. Some of this is through no fault of their own, due to lack of family environment or lack of Catholic education. Others have a doctorate in physics but a second-grade understanding of their Faith, so we find a conscious decision to remain ignorant.

Some Catholics know a great deal about the Bible, but they do not have this knowledge arranged in any kind of systematic format. They have obtained this information by osmosis rather than through organized classes. Although they may not be able to cite chapter and verse, as can some non-Catholics (and I stress "some"), they are surely conversant with the characters and themes of both Testaments.

Interestingly enough, recent polls demonstrate that Catholics and Protestants have no appreciable differences among them in being able to name the four evangelists or twelve apostles; all are rather poor.
