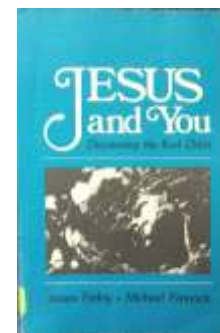

Although there was no damage to the surface of the floor with this, if someone drags the wrong thing, it will be there for the life of the floor. Also, anything with sharp edges on it should not be placed directly on the floor, but on a clean piece of plywood or carpet or cardboard. Parish Center users need to know that the floor is not totally impervious to damage and cannot be repaired cheaply, therefore, extreme caution must be taken anytime the floor is used for anything but Basketball.
