### BIBLE TIDBITS

The four evangelists and their Gospels were believed to have been prefigured by the four living creatures mentioned in the vision of Ezechiel (1,10). Explanations varied, but the opinion of St. Jerome is now the prevailing one. St. Matthew is symbolized by the “man,” because he commences his Gospel with Christ’s earthly ancestry and stresses His human and kingly character. St. Mark is represented by the “lion,” because he starts his Gospel with St. John the Baptist, “the voice of one crying in the desert,” and emphasizes the miraculous powers of the Savior. St. Luke is typified by the “ox,” the animal of sacrifice, because he begins with the history of Zachary the priest offering sacrifice to God, and accentuates the universal priesthood of Christ. St. John is expressed by the “eagle,” because from the very beginning of his Gospel he soars above the things of the earth and time and dwells upon the divine origin and nature of Jesus.
