**Q:** When was our Church first called “Catholic”? What about the Orthodox Church?

**A:** The first record we have of the Church’s being called “Catholic” goes back to the martyr-bishop of Antioch, St. Ignatius, who died around **AD 107**. In his Epistle to the Smyrnaeans, he says: “Where the bishop appears, there let the people be, just as where Jesus Christ is, there is the Catholic Church.” If it is true that some of the Johannine works of the New Testament were not completed until AD 110 or AD 120, we can see that even a decade earlier, the Church was called “Catholic.”

The Orthodox Church called herself “orthodox” (faithful to true teaching) to distinguish her from Christian groups she considered heterodox or heretical. Among those, the Orthodox Church would traditionally place the Catholic Church.
