## “He Has Overcome The World!”

### “Mary and the Resurrection”

(...Venerable Louis of Granada—Magnificat)

**“This is the day which the Lord hath made; let us be glad and rejoice therein.”**

All the days are the Lord's, for he is the Creator of time, but he is said to have made this day in a special way because on this day he completed the work of our redemption. And since this is the work of God par excellence, the day on which he terminated it is the greatest of days. This is the day that the Lord has made because everything in it was effected by himself. On other feasts there is always something of ourselves, at least as a result of our sins, but this is not a day of sin or suffering but the fulfillment of glory. Therefore, everything in this day is of God.

On this day the humanity of Christ rejoiced, the Mother of Christ rejoiced, the disciples of Christ rejoiced, heaven and earth rejoiced, and even hell itself was an unwilling witness to this joy...Who can comprehend Mary's happiness?...So great was Mary's joy that her heart could not have stood the force of it were it not for a special help from God. O Blessed Virgin, this one good suffices. It is enough that your Son lives and stands before you. There is nothing else for you to desire. O Lord, how well you know how to comfort those who suffer for you. The suffering seems nothing when compared to this joy. If thus you comfort those who suffer for you, blessed are the sufferings that are thus rewarded.

### Divine Mercy Sunday

#### A Special Promise of Mercy

Our Lord's promise to grant complete forgiveness of sins and punishment on the Feast of Mercy is recorded three times in the Diary of Saint Faustina, each time in a slightly different way:

1. "I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy" (1109).
2. "Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" (300).
3. "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" (699).

### Easter Graces of New Growth

(...Father J. M Sullivan, O.P. —Magnificat)

One of the more striking aspects of Jesus' parables is the fact that he never uses examples of carpentry. He does not refer to cutting boards or shaving them or even nailing them. It seems strange that a craft which formed the earliest years of his life is absent from his preaching. Instead, Jesus preaches about vineyards and planting sees, about sheep and even fishing.

In these great days of Holy Week and the Easter season, we are blessed anew with the graces of Christ's Resurrection. His new life is given to us in every sacrament throughout the year, of course, but something about celebrating Easter helps those graces find fertile ground within us.

Jesus does not use carpentry to describe this new life of his because it is not a matter of cutting and shaving and nailing into place dead pieces of wood. Rather, life in Christ is about growth and time and fruitfulness. The wheat needs to grow. The prodigal son needs time to think of what he has done to his father. The vineyards need to bear their fruit in proper season. Life in Christ is not about wood already cut from a dead tree, but about the dead tree just on the edge of rebirth. And every good carpenter knows there is no human way to measure that.
