Ascension of Our Lord Sunday May 20th.

The Ascension contains the great mystery of why Jesus must visibly leave his disciples, thus creating a physical void in their midst.....This event marks a major turning point in the story of Jesus' relationship with mankind, because this blessing is as if Jesus were saying to them: "I leave for

heaven so that your own hands may now become my hands, your deeds my deeds, your heart my heart." ...They must now themselves *become* what they have learned to admire and love.....In other words, Jesus now ceases to be but one person in one physical body among many in the world so that the Church corporately and in every individual member can become the presence of his Body on earth. Jesus disappears as single individual in order to fill the whole world with his presence. From now on, those who want to see Jesus, the Messiah, will have to look to the Church and her members—for better or for worse.

Pentecost Sunday May 27th. (The Jewish feast of Pentecost)

Pentecost began as a Jewish celebration of the wheat harvest in the late spring. No specific date was set—it took place when the harvest was ready.

Gradually it became customary to celebrate the feast 50 days after the Passover. This gave it additional meaning Jewish scholars had calculated that when their ancestors left Egypt, they arrived at Mount Sinai approximately 50 days later. It was there that God gave them the law and made a covenant with them: "I will be your God, and you will be my people." Thus, Pentecost became a time for Jewish people to celebrate the covenant that made them God's chosen people.

If this Church was the work of human beings only, it would have died a thousand deaths. Today we give thanks for the presence of the Spirit. Our hope, our trust and our security are not ultimately in the human abilities of popes, bishops, priests. We are secure because the Spirit is with us...because Jesus promised to send the Spirit and Jesus is true to his word...because the Spirit remains with us for better or for worse, despite our frailties, mistakes and failings. God does not give us a perfect Church—our sins and failures are always with us. He gives us a Church that does not fall irretrievably into error and sinfulness because the Spirit remains with us. That is enough.
