#### ***Does Sin Hurt God?***

**Q:** *I believe that we need to make reparation to God for our offenses. When I try to tell others that, I am countered with, "God is in heaven; He can't be hurt by our sins!" I am always at a loss for a good response.*

**A:** Of course, God cannot be hurt by our offenses, in terms of His absolute state of perfection, which theologians speak of as God's intrinsic glory. However, His extrinsic glory is affected by our failures to lead lives worthy of our Christian calling. When people outside the Church see us sinning, they question not only our holiness and/or sincerity but also the whole meaning of life in the Church and, ultimately, the power of Christ to transform human lives.

At a more personal level, it is worthwhile to reflect on how a god of love can be wounded by our refusals to love. The most powerful lesson of God's vulnerability is found by gazing at a crucifix as we behold God, in Christ, literally loving us to death. Many spiritual writers down the centuries have noted that the psychological torment our Lord suffered on the cross ( from the hatred of His persecutors and from what He knew would be man's consistently ungrateful response to His love revealed in His saving death) brought Him far greater pain than the physical agony.
