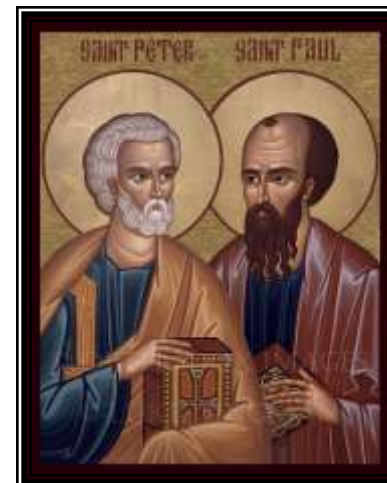
As the snow is starting to fly, is it too early to start thinking about summer? We have finalized the dates!! **Family Camp 2013— JULY 18 – 21, 2013**
