END OF YEAR GIFT-TAXING RULES

The Diocesan Finance Dept., has instructed this office on end of year tax donations:

- If you plan on doing so**—please remit your gift/donation into the parish office on or before Thursday -December 27th. The last 2012 deposit will be made on the 27th, by 3pm.
- If you mail in your gift, and it is **post-marked before Jan. 1st, 2013**, it can be posted for 2012.
- But** if your gift comes in after January 1st (by hand to the office or is postmarked in 2012), it must be posted to the new year-2013, regardless of when a check was dated.
