"A wedding is a day, a marriage is a lifetime."

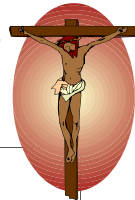
Engaged couples need to schedule a meeting with Father at least 6 months before the proposed marriage date to begin the necessary preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage.

Parish Center Rental Information

from your Parish Council and Father Mariusz

February 14, our SPP Parish Council met and discussed rental costs for our new parish center/gym. A report was presented based on the 2012 expenses.

Parish Center Average Monthly Expenses-2012:

Parishioners: an average cost per month was taken of all expenses to run, clean, supply and repair the parish center/gym in the year 2012, and that average is **\$2,500 per month** --not including property and liability insurance. Thus the need to charge for its use. There is no compensation for the person who volunteers to continually be on call to accommodate the users of the facilities. No compensation is made to the person who makes repairs for damages inflicted to the facilities.

Revised rental rates for parishioners are as follows:

Gym use: \$35 per hour for 0-4 hours, \$200 thereafter
Kitchen use: \$50

Minimal use (including entry hall and minimal kitchen, e.g. sink): by donation

Diocesan insurance (if no Certificate of Liability is provided): \$105*this is a cost required by our diocesan insurance carrier and funds are sent directly to the Diocese. The parish has no choice.*

Cleaning/ damage deposit: \$300.....*this check is returned to the renter if there is no damage or need for extra cleaning after the event.*

No changes were made to the rental rates for **youth sports**, which are as follows:

Gym use: \$35 hour
Setup/clean up fee: \$50
Diocesan insurance (if no Certificate of Liability is provided): \$105

All Diocesan insurance payments and completed forms must be at the diocesan office two weeks before the event. Certificates of Liability also must be presented to the parish office if diocesan insurance is not purchased.
