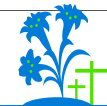
#### COFFEE HOURS AND RELIGIOUS ITEMS

#### Idaho Catholic Foundation UPDATE

A May 7th report from the Diocese states that Sts. Peter and Paul Parish has gifted **\$61,300.00** to our Idaho Church's efforts to maintain its needs in leading and caring for our people.
