UPDATE ON OUR COMING CHURCH BELL

When this bell sounds with a beautiful ring from our church to the whole community, it will be a blessing to us and to all!

The Women's Group of SP&P started a project to purchase a bell approximately 5 years ago and we now have the \$7,000 we needed at that time. BUT unfortunately we find the price has gone up to \$15,000. It is a 34" Meneely used bell that will be polished and can be set to ring during the Angelus, weekend Masses, funerals, etc.

Generous donations ranging from \$25 to \$2,200, and memorials of loved ones, have been gifted toward this project to date. We sincerely thank all who have gifted.
