**“Martyrs:** Atheism is the most vicious cause of killing in the history of the world. That is why we look back on the 20th Century and the primary age of martyrs. There are an estimated 75 million martyrs in the history of the Church over the last 2000 years. So many people died for the love of Christ and their commitment to Him. But of those 75 million, 45 million died in the 20th Century at the hands of Communists, the Nazis and Fascists and other groups who mostly did that killing in the name of atheistic ideologies. And they certainly did it in the name of putting the state ahead of God. The Age of Martyrs is not from the time of the 1st centuries under Rome, but primarily the 20th Century.
