WHAT TO GIVE UP FOR LENT:

- 10 New "Little" Ideas To Challenge And Inspire You!**
1. Don't eat the last bite of your food
 2. Get to know your neighbors
 3. When you wake up, jump out of bed, kiss the floor, and learn humility
 4. Leave a post-it note with a positive message on it wherever you go
 5. Send a different person from the parish an affirmation email or card every week during Lent
 6. At the end of every day, write down one thing that drew you closer to Christ that day
 7. Make a list of 40 people who have touched your life in one way or another. Each day, pray specifically for one of those people.
 8. Adopt a priest or seminarian for our Diocese--pray for them, send a care package, visit them if possible.
 9. Pray the "Hail Mary" and do an ab crunch for every single word
 10. Consider giving up an everyday comfort like a hot shower, your pillow, etc. at least one day a week.
