IDAHO CATHOLIC APPEAL ~ 2014 Update

Goal: \$32,613 ~~~ Required to meet: \$29,352

- ◆ Paid to Date: \$22,945 / 70.36% of goal
- ◆ 69 out of 226 parish households have gifted
- ◆ \$9,668 is still needed to meet the required 100%
- ◆ \$6,407 still needed to meet the 90%— required.
- ◆ If the other 157 households who haven't gifted would give \$100, our goal would be met.
- ◆ **Our parish will be assessed the amount not met ~ which is a Diocesan requirement.**

Please remember two fundamental principles upon which our behavior and attitudes in church rest:

1) **SHOW REVERENCE TOWARD THE TABERNACLE/ALTAR BEFORE SITTING OR KNEELING IN THE PEW.** Genuflection is preferred, but a profound bow will suffice if one is physically incapable of genuflecting. The purpose of this is show respect and reverence for our King and to acknowledge His Real Presence in the tabernacle.

2.) **KNEEL OR SIT QUIETLY.** We do this so that we can pray, meditate, and properly prepare ourselves for the beauty and splendor of the Mass, and to be considerate of those around us, who are also in contemplation of this awesome Reality.

3) **TO HELP QUIET OUR LITTLE ONES.** Feel free to use the church's cry room to comfort your babies and small children, especially during the Homily and Consecration.
