### A Happy and Blessed Easter to Everyone! RESURRECTION MEDITATION

The facts are so clear, my king. You were dead. The Centurion pierced Your heart before he'd let Joseph of Arimathea take You down from the Cross. If there were any possibility that You were still alive, Mary and Your friends never would have let You be buried. As it was, You were enclosed in a small tomb with the entrance sealed. Secondly, there is no question about the identity of Your tomb. The Pharisees saw to that. It was guarded carefully and sealed by men whose hatred and fear would let them take no chances of making a mistake.

And yet, my King, on Easter Sunday morning the tomb was empty! Dead bodies don't move. Some unbelievers will say that the Apostles stole Your Body. But how—with the guard of soldiers there? And why? If they were afraid to fight for You when You were alive, how would they have the courage to risk their lives when You were dead? Other rationalists will claim that an earthquake swallowed Your Body. But Peter and John found the linen shroud and face cloth wrapped neatly in the tomb. It would be a most considerate earthquake that would swallow Your Body and neatly fold the shroud!

There's only one explanation of the empty tomb, my King! The angel expressed it perfectly to the women: "Why do you seek the living One among the dead?" You had risen as You said, glorious and immortal!

### IDAHO CATHOLIC APPEAL ~ 2014 Update

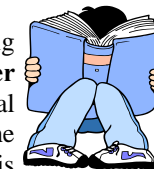
**Goal: \$32,613 ~~~ Required to meet: \$29,352**

- ◆ Paid to Date: \$23,735 / 72.78% of goal

Please remember some fundamental principles upon which our behavior and attitudes in church rest:

1. **PARTICIPATE FULLY IN THE MASS.** We do this by immersing ourselves totally in the Mass by diligently listening to GOD's Word, participating in the prayers, and being properly disposed to receive The King of the Universe Himself in The Eucharist.

2. **STAY UNTIL THE END OF MASS.** Mass is not concluded until the final prayer and dismissal, and it is the polite thing to do to remain in the pew until the end of the recessional song, since it is, after all, a sung prayer.

3. **REVERENTLY, GENTLY, & SILENTLY LEAVE THE CHURCH.** Again these actions by the congregation demonstrate due respect for our Lord in The Blessed Sacrament. There is plenty of time to share camaraderie and conviviality once we have left the worship space of the Church, and, furthermore, we avoid the possibility of disturbing those who wish to remain behind in the church for contemplation and prayer. ...
