Please remember some fundamental principles upon which our behavior and attitudes in church rest:



- 1. No bulletin reading during Mass.** Imagine if you invited a guest to your house and before dinner (or during) they decided to read a magazine instead of talking to you..
- 2. Respect Boundaries others may have.** You might want to hold hands to pray, they may not. They might be sick and not want to shake during the sign of peace. These are all OK. Do not make any unnecessary judgment because they worship differently.
- 3. Bow before receiving Holy Communion.** If it is God, then show your respect with a bow of the head.
- 4. Do not receive from the chalice if you are sick.** This is an act of charity.
- 5. Do not leave early.** We should stay to the end of the recession and the hymn that accompanies it, if there is one.
- 6. Pray after Mass, if you can.** It is a good custom, though not required, to offer a prayer of thanksgiving after Mass is over. What could be more important?
