SAINT PETER CLAVER

A native of Catalonia, Spain, Peter joined the Jesuits in 1601 and was ordained in Cartagena (now in Colombia), the chief slave market of South America. Ten thousand African slaves arrived in the port very month. Peter was there to meet the ships. He entered the holds filled with the smell of rotting flesh, bearing food and medicines, brandy and sweets. "We must speak to them with our hands," he said, "before we try to speak to them with our lips." With the aid of interpreters and illustrations of Christ's life, Peter taught the brutalized slaves about the mercy of God. In thirty-three years, he instructed and baptized over 300,000 slaves. He died in 1654.
