END OF YEAR GIFT-TAXING RULES
 The **Diocesan Finance Department** has instructed this office on **end of year tax donations:**

- 1. If you intend on making a 2014 donation to SPP Parish for tax purposes, please remit your gift into the parish office before Wednesday-December 31 by noon. The last deposit will be made for 2014 by 12:30pm.**
- 2. If you mail in your gift, and it is post-marked before Jan. 1st, 2015, it can be posted for 2014.**
- 3. But if your gift comes in after January 1st (by hand to the office or is postmarked in 2015), it must be posted to the new year-2015, regardless of when the check was dated.**
