END OF YEAR GIFT-TAXING RULES

The *Diocesan Finance Department* has instructed this office on end of year tax donations:

1.) If you intend on making a 2014 donation to SPP Parish for tax purposes, please remit your gift into the parish office before Wednesday-December 31 by noon. The last deposit will be made for 2014 by 12:30pm.

2.) If you mail in your gift, and it is post-marked before Jan. 1st, 2015, it can be posted for 2014.

3.) But if your gift comes in after January 1st (by hand to the office or is postmarked in 2015), it must be posted to the new year-2015, regardless of when the check was dated.

### Our New Missals & Music Books

Our new books come from GIA Publications and will save our parish \$20,000. Before we had to change out the missals four times (at cost) a year and the music books one time a year (at cost), plus the task of hauling to the recycle bin.

The new books contain all three liturgical year cycles of readings, A,B,C. If parishioners will familiarize themselves with the book, soon it will be very simple to follow along in the Mass.

1. The Order of the Mass is marked at the second BLUE page marking which is toward the front of the book.
2. The Hymns are placed in the center of the book.
3. The Mass Readings are placed toward the end of the book. Each Sunday's readings number is placed and seen on the top of the hymn numbers board.

With gentle use, the new books will last at least 10 years.
