CGS was developed by Dr. Sofia Cavalletti and Gianna Giobbi in Rome in 1954 and spread throughout the world. It is currently in over 37 countries. It is used in homes, parishes and schools.

### Stations of the Cross

Traditionally, Lenten devotions in parish churches have drawn attention to the suffering and death of Jesus.

The most popular one is known as the Stations of the Cross. During the time of the crusades (1095-1270), it became popular for pilgrims to the Holy Land to walk in the footsteps of Jesus to



Calvary. In the next two centuries, after the Moslems recaptured the Holy Land, pilgrimages were too dangerous.

A substitute pilgrimage, the Stations of the Cross, became popular outdoors throughout Europe. They represented critical events from Scripture or tradition of Jesus' journey to Calvary. In the mid-8th century Stations were allowed inside churches. Eventually fixed at fourteen, the Stations became a familiar feature in Catholic churches. In the 1960s, it became popular to add a fifteenth station representing the end of the journey: the Resurrection.
