The Ascension of Our Lord (Theme: Heaven and Earth)

Not all members of our species have the same outlook on life. There are people for whom this life means everything and “heaven” nothing. Naturally good people, they may cherish love as a great value, but they believe that when death comes, that is the end. There are others for whom “heaven” is all-important and this life almost completely unimportant. Save your soul! Many Christians have cherished this outlook, especially concerning others and as long as the self was not involved. Finally, we have those for whom “heaven” is realized already on earth in love!

If we understand Jesus’ philosophy of life well, and try to understand the exaltation of his humanity as we celebrate it today, we could give it a try. We may live life, including marital love, as an earthly reality. We may develop our potential as earthlings to its fullest. We may make use of the results of science (sociology, etc.) to achieve a better life on this planet. We may consult marriage counselors and psychiatrists and seek the best medical care available. Yet in our best moments (“disclosure situations”), we know that there must be something more than all of this, a transcending reality.

In faith, following Jesus of Nazareth, we see this “transcending reality” as a loving Father who is waiting for us. He (Jesus) is the beginning: “Where he, our head, has gone, we his members, hope to follow him”. “God our Father, ...may we follow him (Jesus) into the new creation, for his ascension is our glory and our hope”.
