### A SMALL LITURGICAL CHANGE AT OUR WEEKEND MASSES

To enable our Masses to flow smoothly, a small change will be incorporated at our weekend Masses. **Altar servers—please note.**

- ♦ **Our Cross Bearer will proceed to the back of the church after the Prayers of the Faithful and immediately return with the gift bearers and the bread and wine to Father John at the Altar.**
- ♦ **THEN...**the collection will be taken up while Father is preparing the “Offertory”. The collection basket will be brought up and placed in front of the altar by the usher.

### IN THE FUTURE~ ~ AN ADDITION

#### TO THE BEGINNING OF OUR WEEKEND MASSES:

To create a more welcoming atmosphere to all parishioners and visitors, we will begin having an MC (master of ceremony) who will be at the Ambo before the beginning of the Mass, and present to the parish the following:



- \* a sincere welcome to all and thank you for coming
- \* apprising the parish of a visiting priest on occasion of this need
- \* any needed event or announcement
- \* finally—they will come forward and read the “Prayers of the Faithful” and the “Responsorial Psalm”

Obviously, we will need volunteers for this, as it will be a ministry all its own.

- **Assigned Lectors** for their weekend Mass **cannot** be used as an MC at their assigned Mass, as they are specified for the **Word of God...only.**
- Other Lectors, not assigned for that particular Mass, can be an MC. The MC will be included in the ongoing “servers list” in the bulletin.
- The written information will be provided and placed on the Ambo for the MC.
- **Please pray and call the parish office or talk to Fr. John and step forward for this ministry need. Many other parishes have this helpful, active and meaningful ministry in place.**
