A SMALL LITURGICAL CHANGE AT OUR WEEKEND MASSES

To enable our Masses to flow smoothly, a small change will be incorporated at our weekend Masses.

Altar servers—please note.

◇ **Our Cross Bearer will proceed to the back of the church after the Prayers of the Faithful and immediately return with the gift bearers and the bread and wine to Father John at the Altar.**

◇ **THEN...**the collection will be taken up while Father is preparing the “Offertory”. The collection basket will be brought up and placed in front of the altar by the usher.

MRC's at Weekend Masses

To create a welcoming atmosphere to all parishioners and visitors, our parish will begin having an MC (master of ceremony) who will be at the Ambo before the beginning of the Mass, and present to the parish the following:



- * a sincere welcome to all and thank you for coming
- * apprising the parish of a visiting priest on occasion of this need
- * any event announcement
- * finally—they will come forward and read...the “Prayers of the Faithful” and ...the “Responsorial Psalm”
- *the written information will be provided and placed on the Ambo for the MC.

We need volunteers for this ministry. Please call the parish office to offer help. In the beginning, our active Lectors will be starting this ministry.

- Assigned Lectors for their weekend Mass **cannot** be used as an MC at their assigned Mass, as they are specified for the **Word of God...only.**
- Many other parishes have this helpful, active and meaningful ministry in place.
