Jesus then took the loaves, and when he had given thanks, he distributed them to those who were seated; so also the fish, as much as they wanted.

CCC1360: The formula expressed here is very close to the description in the Synoptic Gospels of the actions of Christ at the Last Supper, where he instituted the Eucharist. (cf Mt 26:26; Mk 14:22; Lk 22:19) Given thanks: This term in Greek is *eucharisteo*, whence “Eucharist.”
