RELIGIOUS EDUCATION FOR OUR CHILDREN**

#2223: Parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children.
#2225: Parents should initiate their children at an early age into the mysteries of the faith of which they are the “first heralds” for their children.
#2226: Education in the faith by the parents should begin in the child’s earliest years. This already happens when family members help one another to grow in faith by the witness of a Christian life in keeping with the Gospel.The parish is the Eucharistic community and the heart of the liturgical life of Christian families; it is a privileged place for the catechesis of children and parents.
