Why do Catholics Do that ?

Make the Sign of the Cross: Catholics often make the sign of the cross and say "In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" when they begin and end a prayer, when entering, leaving or passing a church, or when receiving communion to name a few times. **This sign is meant to remind us of the Trinity and to be an outward profession of our beliefs and of our status as Catholics.**

Why the Holy Water: Similar to how the Old Testament Jewish people would purify themselves with water before entering to worship, we Catholics will make the sign of the cross with Holy Water as we enter or exit a church or home. We use Holy water for baptisms and blessing items as well. **Holy water is meant to accomplish 3 purposes: To signify the believer's repentance from sin, to be a reminder of our baptism, and to help protect us from evil.**

Why genuflect when entering and exiting a pew: For the same reason people centuries ago would have bowed briefly when in front of a king: **To show respect. And who deserves respect more than the true King of Kings, who is present in the church?**

As SPP Parish is preparing for the new school year, we also offer additional Religious Ed classes for those who are not able to attend Sts. Peter and Paul School or for students just wanting additional study. For these classes, Grades 1-5 meet after school on Wednesdays and Grades 6-8 meet on Sunday evenings.
