MASS GIFT BEARERS: Father John has requested that “families” bring the gifts up to the front for Mass. His instruction is that different families each week rise at the end of the Nicene Creed, acquire the bread and wine from the vestibule and stand ready during the Prayers of the Faithful. When this prayer is finished, then proceed immediately to Father. In the near future our parish is considering assigning families for each Mass. (This is done in other parishes) One Mass for a family in a two month period cannot be too much to ask to fulfill this ministry. If a family is assigned and for some reason cannot be in attendance that weekend, then the family can call another family on the servers list and ask if they would switch weekends. *This can be a beautiful addition to our precious Mass worshipping our Lord Jesus which is why we are there in the first place.*

Father John will soon be presenting a class for all present Altar Servers and any new students interested in becoming an Altar Server. But first Father would like to have **all these students and their parents** attend a short meeting after the Saturday evening Mass on September 12th.

EXTRA-ORDINARY EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS:

At weekend Masses only, Father John will be the only distributor of the Precious Body. We will now have four Precious Blood cups, two on each side. The servers list already has 3 EEM’s assigned for the next two months, but now our Mass needs another EEM who is present at Mass to come forward to serve as the fourth EEM. The Nov/Dec list will have four EEM’s. Thank you for your help and serving.

MEMO TO OUR PARISH FAMILY

On Saturday August 29 after the Evening Mass, a meeting was held between Father John and the people that have been attending Eucharistic Adoration. The importance of the Eucharist was explained, on how the Eucharist is not only part of the Mass but it flows from the Mass and leads back to the Mass. Father John will be the only person (except Deacon Don) in charge of exposing and reposing the Blessed Sacrament, in future.

“We are encouraging communal participation, not so much how many hours is the Eucharist exposed but the quality of the exposition on how many people can come together to worship.” ... Fr. John

It was noted that for the twelve hours of Adoration that have been scheduled only assigned people showed up for that hour and always the same people. To start encouraging participation, we will be changing how we have been celebrating Adoration. In addition to Tuesdays Holy Hour, we will be adding new opportunities for everyone to come visit the Blessed Sacrament.

*We are now having one Holy Hour every Friday after the morning Mass from 9-10 am.

*Every Saturday before the Saturday evening Mass from 4-5:15 we will be having a Holy Hour of Exposition/Adoration, Confession and Rosary prayers.

*Every Sunday from 7am- 7:50am, we will have Exposition/Adoration, Confession and the Rosary being prayed within a Holy Hour.

Even though it looks like we are taking 12 hours of Adoration a month away that is not the case. We are simply moving the schedule around. We will still have the 12 hours of Adoration a month only we are spreading the hours into a weekly format instead of once a month. Please do not hesitate to call me or the office if you have any questions or concerns.
