Jubilee of Mercy Merciful like the Father

Pope Francis has proclaimed an Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy as a special time for the Church "to make more evident its mission to be a witness of mercy." Only the third special jubilee in Church history, this year will be an opportunity to encourage Christians to meet people's real needs with

concrete assistance, and to experience and recognize with gratitude the mercy of God in our own lives.

Chrism Mass will be at 7:00 p.m. Tuesday, March 15 at St. John's Cathedral in Boise. If you are planning on being in Boise we would encourage you to attend. We would especially encourage people to participate in the consecration of the Sacred Chrism used to celebrate their anointing with the Holy Spirit:

- * The Elect, as well as candidates for full communion and confirmation;
- * Confirmation candidates
- * Representatives from our community who serve the ill or homebound.
