During this Year of Mercy, Bishop Peter is delegating to pastors and administrators the general faculty to confirm **all** adult Catholics seeking the Sacrament of one of two dates: Pentecost Sunday on May 15<sup>th</sup>; and the Feast of Christ the King on Sunday, November 20<sup>th</sup>. This allows adult Catholics to be confirmed without undergoing the lengthy process more appropriate to catechumens or teens. If you are an adult Catholic who was never confirmed and would like to receive that sacrament, contact your pastor for instructions and join your parish community in celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation. Adults who may have impediments to confirmation (e.g., marriage irregularities), should seek confirmation on the second date, Christ the King, so that they have time to address these issues, if able to do so.
