

WE'RE ALL IN NEED

Regardless of our position in life, we are all in need of God's mercy, a mercy that he extends so that, despite our poverty, we can be one with him. It is God's mercy that bridges the gap between our humanity and God's divinity, provides us with a model for right relationships, and brings us out of our isolation and into joyful communion with him and with all people.

The Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy are actions we perform that extend God's compassion and mercy.

Corporal Works of Mercy are acts by which we help our neighbors with their material and physical needs:

- feed the hungry
- shelter the homeless
- clothe the naked
- visit the sick and imprisoned
- bury the dead
- give alms to the poor

Spiritual Works of Mercy are acts by which we help our neighbors with their emotional and spiritual needs:

- instruct
- advise
- console
- comfort
- forgive
