Holy Door
 Pope Francis announced an opportunity for Catholics to obtain a plenary indulgence during the Year of Mercy by passing through a designated Holy Door during the Year of Mercy, or performing one of the corporal or spiritual works of mercy; and fulfilling the usual conditions of having the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, receiving sacramental Confession and the Holy Eucharist, and praying for the intentions of the Holy Father. The most prominent Holy Door is located at St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican. This door is famously sealed with brick and mortar until a Jubilee Year. In the rest of the world, the Jubilee Churches will be the diocesan cathedral or any other locations where the local Ordinary decides to open a Door of Mercy. We have a Holy Door very close to us at All Saints Catholic Church in Lewiston, Idaho. There is still time to visit this site.

"Basics of the Catholic Faith"
Morality, Sin and Grace
 Ninth Week

In this particular segment of the course, we will explore and compare human nature as created, as fallen, and as redeemed. What was life like for Adam and Eve before the Fall? What are the real and significant consequences of Original Sin and personal sin? Can we really be happy in this life? What is grace and does it really make a difference? How has our intellect, our free will, and our passions been effected by the Fall and how can they be reformed in grace?

We will discuss these and other related teachings of the Church, along with some practical means by which we can actively engage in the pursuit of true happiness.

Many adult Catholics who are active in their faith have nonetheless never been confirmed. **During this Year of Mercy, Bishop Peter is delegating to pastors and administrators the general faculty to confirm all adult Catholics seeking the Sacrament of Confirmation on the Feast of Christ the King on Sunday, November 20th.** This allows adult Catholics to be confirmed without undergoing the lengthy process more appropriate to catechumens or teens. If you are an adult Catholic who was never confirmed and would like to receive this sacrament, contact the parish office for instructions and join your parish community in celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation with your pastor! Adults who may have impediments to confirmation (e.g., marriage irregularities), should come in as soon as possible, so that they have time to address these issues, if able to do so.
