Parish Religious Education:

A pilot program for Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, for 3 - 6 year olds, will begin in our parish the week of October 23rd. Two sessions will be offered. **Session I** will be held on Sundays following the 8:00 am Mass, and **Session II** will be held on Fridays at 2:05 pm. All sessions will be held in the Atrium located on the first floor of the parish office building. Session I will begin October 23rd, and Session II will begin October 28th. The first sessions will be 60 minutes in length. Over subsequent weeks the session times will gradually be increased to 90 minutes. There will be no fee to participate. Minor Changes during Mass

*Lectors are asked to join the procession into Mass with the Gospel book and then place the book on the stand. If you are a Lector and cannot do this please ask someone to carry the book up with the Procession. A guideline on the procedure is available at the office.

*MCs please let Fr. know who you are in case there are any last minute changes.

*It was brought to Fathers attention that people were arriving later and later during the weekend Masses so as to not interfere with Adoration. As he also has to do confessions, during Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, it was being left alone during Exposition. It was decided to no longer have Adoration before the weekend Mass.

*Sacristans please resume the duties as before we had the Adoration.

* We need more Outreach Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion for the shut-ins we serve. if we cannot find people willing take the time to reach out to them, **we may have to end this program.** This commitment is once a month (usually on Sunday) for an hour or so.
