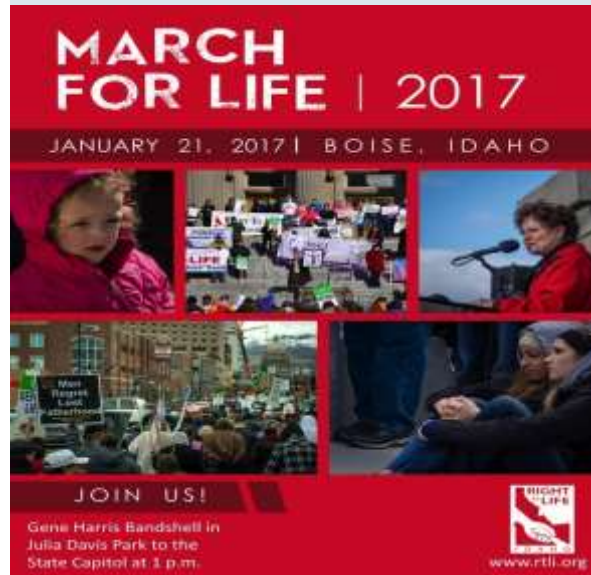
"I'll go where You want me to go, Dear Lord,
