Opportunity for Marian Consecration

In August of last year, Bishop Peter consecrated our diocese of Boise to Our Lady, which is an extremely powerful way of obtaining her intercession as we work to grow closer to Christ. From our diocesan website: "The act of consecration dedicates the diocese and all of the good works that come from it to our Lady and her desires, in order to more fully complete the will of her Son." Following the lead of our Bishop, some Camas Prairie Catholics are organizing a consecration of ourselves and our parishes. All members of the parishes in the area are invited to join with us in preparing for Marian consecration through the 33-day preparation "33 Days to Morning Glory" by Father Michael Gaitley. The book has a wonderful, short meditation for each of the 33 days that helps the soul prepare for consecration. It can be done individually at home and will begin on April 10, which is the Monday of Holy Week and it will end on the 100th anniversary of Fatima, May 13. Imagine how powerful it would be for the whole Prairie if we were to do this all together!!!
