granted permission to use the title “Catholic” in its
name, official documents and marketing materials,
should it choose to do so during this probationary
period.” What this means is that Summit Academy is
now officially accepted as a Catholic School under the
oversight of the Bishop as are all Catholic Schools in the
Diocese. Summit Academy includes grades 1st-12th.
