Dear Parishioners of Holy Trinity:

On December 9, 2016 I requested, with deep regrets, retirement from diaconal service. On Friday, January 20, 2017 I received a letter from Bishop Peter and I would like to share the following paragraph from that letter:

**“With this letter, I do acknowledge your request for resignation. This becomes effective as of January 01, 2017. Obviously, with your resignation, you are no longer under obligation to exercise your diaconal faculties with the Diocese of Boise. However, you do retain those faculties to be used as you and your pastor determine on an individual basis.”**

*This means that I am still able to conduct Rosary and funeral services, witness marriages, and perform Baptisms, lead Liturgy of the Hours, perform Sunday Celebrations in the Absence of a Priest, and of course make home and hospital visits. I will continue to be a servant of the servants. Thank you for all you have done for me in these past 15 years.*
