* Ash Wednesday, the start of the 40-day Lenten season leading up to
Easter, falls on Feb. 14 — Valentine’s Day — this year. The last time
this happened was 1945 and it will not happen again until 2024, 2029
and then not until 2170. On Ash Wednesday and each Friday during
Lent, Catholics are traditionally forbidden from eating meat. To avoid
any potential conflict, Catholic leaders are suggesting celebrating
Valentine’s the day before or during the weekend. Catholics age 14 and
up are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Fridays of
Lent. Adults age 18-59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and
Good Friday having one regular meal and two small meals. Lenten
meditation books are available in the vestibule.

***LENTEN FAMILY NIGHT** will be Tuesday, **Feb. 13th, at St.
Mary’s Church**. The evening will begin with Mass at **6:00
pm** (Ashes will be distributed and this Mass counts for Ash
Wednesday). Mass will be followed by activities for the family
to prepare for Lent. We are also serving a pancake
dinner. ALL ARE WELCOME!

*Stations of the Cross will be on Friday at 6 p.m. during
Lent. Beginning February 16th weekday Masses will be at
6:30 p.m.
