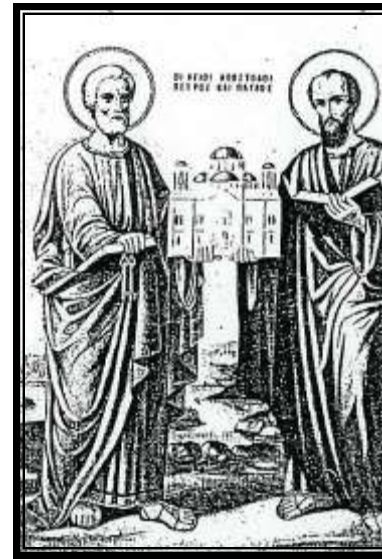
**Fall Conference** ~ September 17-19

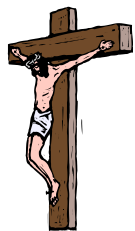
