Late last year the U.S. approved "ethically acceptable human cell lines," so called because they were obtained from "extra fertility clinic embryos with parental consent." Fr. St. Michael the Archangel (means "Who is like God")

Angel of God's power; leader of the heavenly host (Dn 10:13,21; 12:1; Jude 9; Rv 12:7ff) cast Lucifer and fallen angels from heaven (Rv 12:7-9; see Ez 28:17) disputed with Satan over Moses' body; Israel's protector; leader of the Archangels; considered to be the angel who executes the decision on each person's eternal destiny on Judgment Day (hence his scales insignia).
