Craig has had numerous combat experiences and has seen the Taliban face-to-face. Still, he considers other battles to be much more difficult: "Spiritual battles are much more difficult than combat., and more subtle. The devil is very sneaky. He attacks your thoughts and emotions to create anxiety, doubt, fear and double-mindedness. We need spiritual weapons—faith, prayer, conviction and humility."

Craig has recognized that he slowly drifts away from God whenever he neglects prayer. For him, praying with the Bible is key. "When I read the Bible, praying it from the heart, I think about God and his presence in my life—how he wants me to be and how his mercy is always there for me, even though my faith is imperfect.
