#### Who Use & Plan Events For the Gym

\*\*Any items taken into the gym should be carried in or rolled in on a cart with rubber wheels.

\*\***Dragging items:** if someone drags the wrong thing, it will be there for the life of the floor.

\*\***Sharp edges** should not be placed directly on the floor, but on a clean piece of plywood or carpet or cardboard. The floor is not totally impervious to damage and cannot be repaired cheaply.
