### The Gift of the Church (...Msgr. Bob Guste)



Everything we do as Catholic Christians is—Our Lord Jesus Christ. Everything in the Church revolves around Him. Every sacrament of the Church is a meeting with Jesus under a sacred sign. Jesus isn’t walking among us the same way He walked among the people of Galilee or Palestine, but because we’re human beings, we want to be able to see and touch and hear something; we want to contact God in a down-to-earth concrete way. God knows that we want this, that in a certain sense we even need it. And that’s the reason (or at least one of the reasons) for the Incarnation—Jesus Christ, God in the flesh. And that’s the reason for the Church and the sacraments—those sacred signs of His presence, His working among us. Every one of those seven sacraments is a meeting with Jesus Christ.
