### News from Saints Peter & Paul School

In Wednesday's "Lewiston Morning Tribune" the state's expectations for test scores were listed. It reported that the state's goals are:

- 85.6% of students be proficient in reading
  - 83% of students be proficient in math.
- (No language expectations were listed.)

### How does SPPS measure up?

- 91% of SPPS students are proficient in reading
- 88% of SPPS students are proficient in math
- 85% of SPPS students are proficient in language
