




The Greatness of Children

The more clearly and distinctly the student understands the relation of the Creator and the created, the facts concerning the fall of man and redemption, the deep mysteries of the divine inner life of the Trinity, the nature of Christ, the essence and the exalted calling of the Mother of God, the deeper will be her union with divinity, the Redeemer, and the Queen of Heaven.

One can see clearly in the lives of the saints that there advancement in personal sanctity and in a more profound insight into the truths of faith postulate and promote each other reciprocally. This is also precisely true of those saints without a scholarly education. And one need not believe by any means that these deep mysteries exceed the child's powers of comprehension. The strong desire to be introduced to the mysteries of God is often stronger in small children than in adults. And if children are responded to in the right manner with no arbitrary force, then their joyful awareness of getting to know God and of coming closer to him will be accelerated up to the most intensive thinking and living with him.

The severe lack of rainfall has resulted in failed crops and critical shortages in food and water. 
