Biblical Books

Q: *Father Leonard Badia, in his article on the Dead Sea Scrolls, stated that every book of the Old Testament has been found in scroll form or fragments, except for the book of Esther. Did he intend to say that these include the books referred to by Protestants as “apocryphal”?*

A: Yes, that is precisely the point of Father Badia’s remark. The canon of the Bible accepted by the Roman Catholic Church and the Eastern Orthodox is indeed the Septuagint Canon (that is, the longer one). With this archaeological find and other convincing evidence, many Protestant scholars have indicated a willingness to take a second look at these biblical books. In fact, many Protestant editions now contain these works, at least at the end of the Old Testament.

The disputed books are: Tobit, Judith, Wisdom, Sirach, Baruch, 1 and 2 Maccabees, and Esther. Luther had made the first serious move against these books, largely because 2 Maccabees had always been used by the Church in support of the doctrine of purgatory and prayers for the dead.

The Two Thieves

Q: *Please inform me of the names of the two thieves crucified with Jesus. Were they nailed, too?*

A: The Gospels do not give us their names, nor whether or not they were nailed or tied to their crosses. Tradition assigns the name of Dismas to the “good thief,” and Gestus to the other.
