Continued from last week's bulletin:

Our school days begin with communal prayer led each morning in our classrooms. This time includes reading from Scripture, special intentions, songs of worship, and memorized prayer. We plan to include an all school morning prayer in the 2011-2012 school year, now that we have the physical space to do so. In addition to morning, mealtime, and end-of-day prayers, our students are encouraged to keep Christ present with them throughout the day. Students are lead to express gratitude and praise to God for the triumphs of their days and are also guided to handle difficult situations through private or group prayer. Our students learn that there are many ways to pray, and that God wants to have a personal relationship with each of them. We strive to help God become "real" in their lives by providing authentic examples through the testimonies of our school and parish community members and begin a student mentoring program.

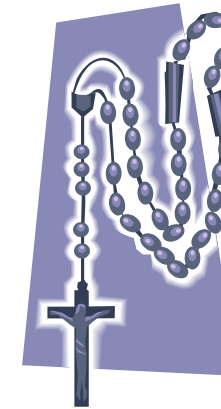
Our staff and entire student body is blessed to have the opportunity to celebrate Mass twice a week with fellow parishioners. The liturgy is prepared weekly by one of our four combined classes. Students actively participate as lectors, servers and musicians. We use the reading of the day identified by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops with music and petitions chosen to enhance those readings. In addition to our bi-weekly school liturgical celebrations we are privileged to prepare and lead the Sunday liturgy during Catholic School's Week and take our turn leading Stations of the Cross during Lent. These opportunities to celebrate together are an example of our school being an active, vibrant part of our parish.

**From the Catholic Source Book : pg. 248
The Mass in A.D. 150**

By the apologist Justin, martyr, this passage is from his First Apology, 67, which was rediscovered in the sixteenth century.

"On the day called Sunday there is a meeting in one place of those who live in cities or the country, and the memoirs of the apostles or the writings of the prophets are read as long as time permits. When the reader has finished, the president in a discourse urges and invites us to the imitation of these noble things. Then we all stand up together and offer prayers. And, as said before, when we have finished the prayer, bread is brought, and wine and water, and the president similarly sends up prayers and thanksgivings to the best of his ability, and the congregation assents, saying the Amen; the distribution, and reception of the consecrated elements by each one, takes place and they are sent to the absent by the deacons. Those who prosper, and who so wish, contribute, each one as much as he chooses to. What is collected is deposited with the president, and he takes care of orphans and widows, and those who are in want on account of sickness or any other cause, and those who are in bonds, and the strangers who are sojourners among us, and, briefly, he is the protector of all those in need."
