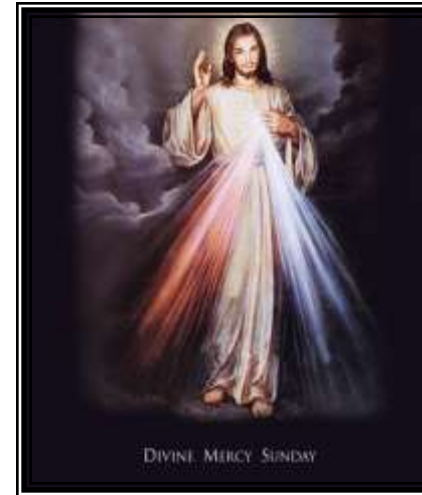

“ Divine Mercy Devotions”



**Sunday ~ Tonight
Divine Mercy

The devotion of the Divine Mercy Chaplet will be prayed along with other ascribed prayers involved with this devotion.

“At three o'clock , implore My Mercy, especially for sinners; and , if only for a brief moment , immerse yourself in My Passion, particularly in my abandonment at the moment of agony. This is the hour of great Mercy for the whole world. I will allow you to enter into my mortal sorrow. In this hour, I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of me in virtue of My Passion.” (Diary)

☼“Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.” (Diary 300)

☼”The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.” (Diary 699)

☼“My great delight is to unite Myself with souls...When I come to a human heart in Holy Communion, My hands are full of all kinds of graces which I want to give to the soul. But souls do not even pay any attention to Me; they leave Me to Myself and busy themselves with other things. Oh, how sad I am that souls do not recognize Love! They treat me as a dead object.” (Diary 1385)

(Jesus... as told to St. Faustina - “Diary of a Soul”)
