### Corpus Christi

The Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, popularly called by its Latin title, *Corpus Christi* ("Body of Christ"), is celebrated on the second Sunday after Pentecost. Its origin in the 12th century is connected with an exaggerated emphasis on the real presence of Christ in the consecrated bread to be adored to the exclusion of a fuller meaning of Eucharist as celebration, a meal to be eaten. People in the Middle Ages, feeling unworthy to receive this Christ in communion, preferred to look at the Blessed Sacrament. This led to the introduction of an elevation of the bread and cup during Mass and ultimately to public displays such as the popular Benediction ritual. The special feast devoted to the Body and Blood of Christ was introduced to the universal church in 1264. St. Thomas Aquinas wrote the prayers and hymns for the feast.

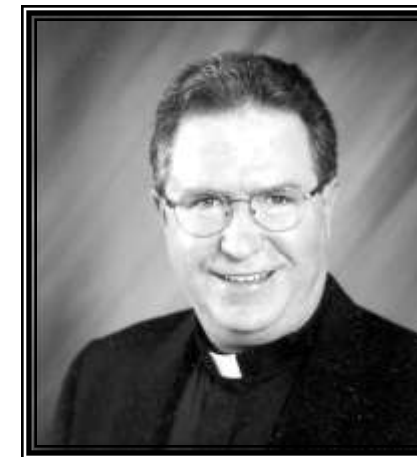
